Sewer Collection System – Second Phase

News Release Update

On February 11th, 2010, the District's Local Area Service - Sewer Collection Second Phase Bylaw No. 775, 2009 received Statutory Approval from the Province. The Council of the District of Sicamous subsequently adopted Bylaw No. 775, 2009 on February 24th, 2010.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Community Charter, upon expiration of the statutory quashing period, which extends for one month after the date of adoption of the bylaw, the District will make application for Certificate of Approval. Once the Certificate of Approval is received, the District is in a position to borrow the funds authorized by the bylaw.

During the thirty day period, the District will determine the order in which the phases will proceed and the District's engineer will start to prepare the Tender Documents.

Once the order has been determined, property owners within the first phase of construction can expect to receive a letter from the District providing them with the time table for the project, when it will commence, anticipated duration, contact information for the contractor/engineer, and as many details as possible in relation to specific properties.

After each construction phase is completed and tested, the District will determine how and when property owners may connect to the system.

The District will provide additional information on the process as it evolves.
